The new catering contract officially starts next week.</p> <p>Lots of trips are already planned for the coming weeks and health week is due to take place week commencing 21st June. 6	<p>AGM.</p> <p>Lisa Lewtas and Caroline French will be stepping down as Chairperson and secretary respectively at the end of this school year.
